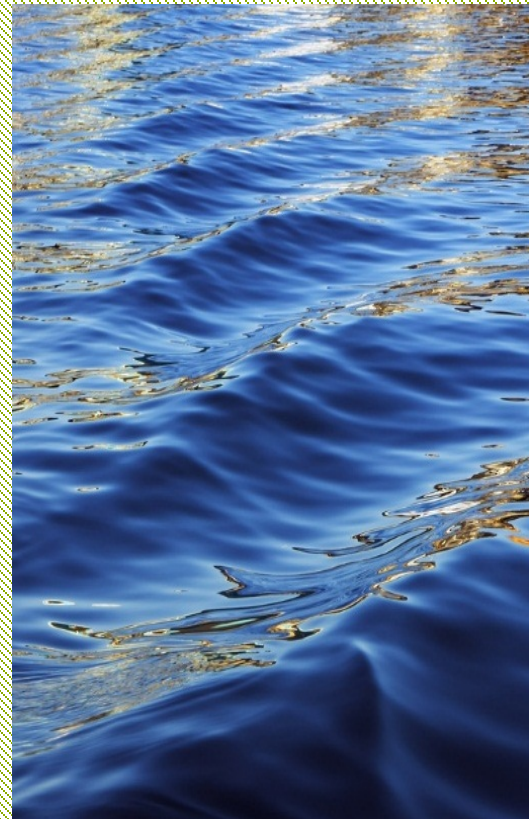

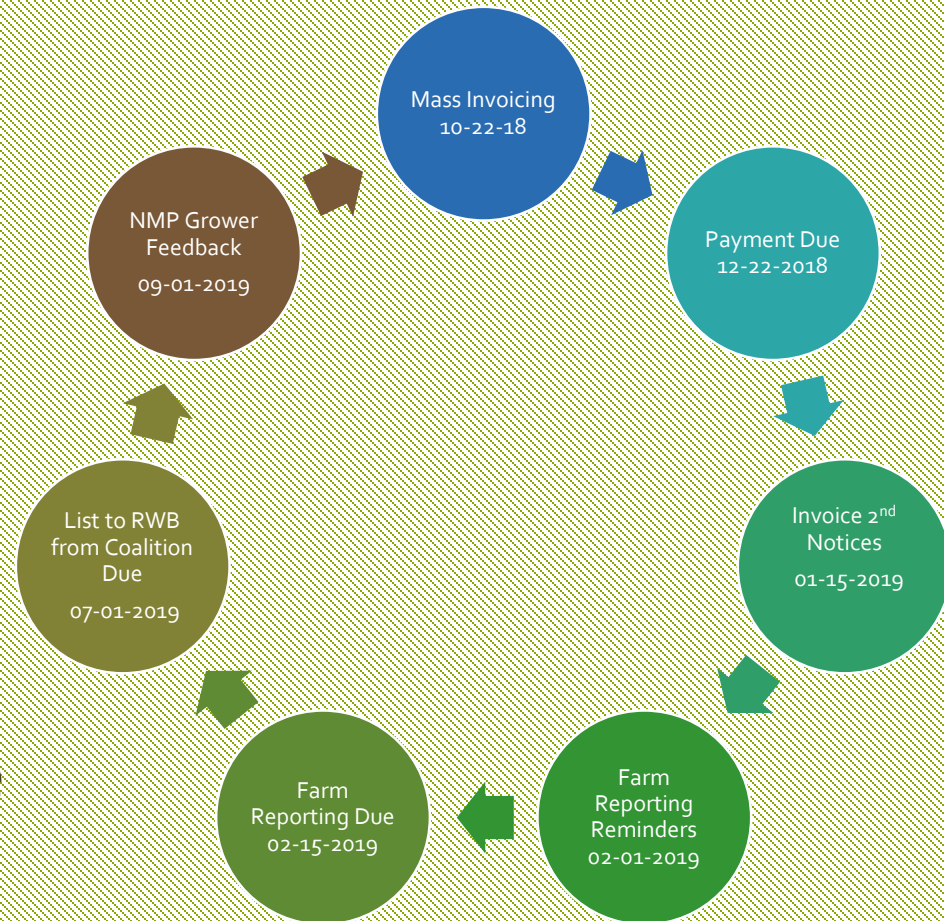

Membership Life Cycle

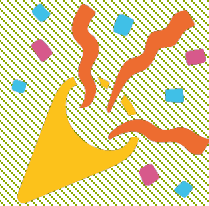
- Invoices sent to Members

- Farm reporting reminders sent
- Farm reporting due (NMPSR)
- List to the Regional Board from Coalition-Members are revoked for either lack of farm reporting or payment
- NMP Grower Feedback



Membership Stats

Farm reporting for 2017 crop year

- Farm evaluations-100%
- NMPSR-100%



Payment for 2017 crop year (Fiscal year 2018)



- Payments-99%
- Memberships revoked-2 for lack of payment

Education requirements



- 97% of members reported their education
- Memberships that did not report their education to us were reported to the Regional Board

Membership Updates

Farm reporting for 2018 crop year

- No farm evaluations required until crop year 2020 (2021)
 - Then every five years
- NMPSR required for parcels that are high for groundwater vulnerability – Due date is:
FEBRUARY 15, 2019
(Late fees apply if after that date)
- Memberships will be revoked for lack of reporting

Membership Updates

Payment for 2018 crop year

- Due 12/22/2018
- Memberships will be revoked for lack of payment

Education requirements for 2018 crop year

- Keep track of your education so you can report it to the Coalition
- Memberships that do not report their education to the Coalition will be reported to the Regional Board

Membership Updates

Farm reporting possibilities...



- The Regional Board knows now that dialing in on specific issues is more important than requiring annual reporting for farm practices from everyone...
- There is always a potential for specific surveys as part of a Management Plan. These would be in response to issues we see in water quality monitoring (management practice implementation reports).

Regional Board Enforcement

Enrollment

- Two landowners received NOV (notice of violation) letters for lack of enrollment

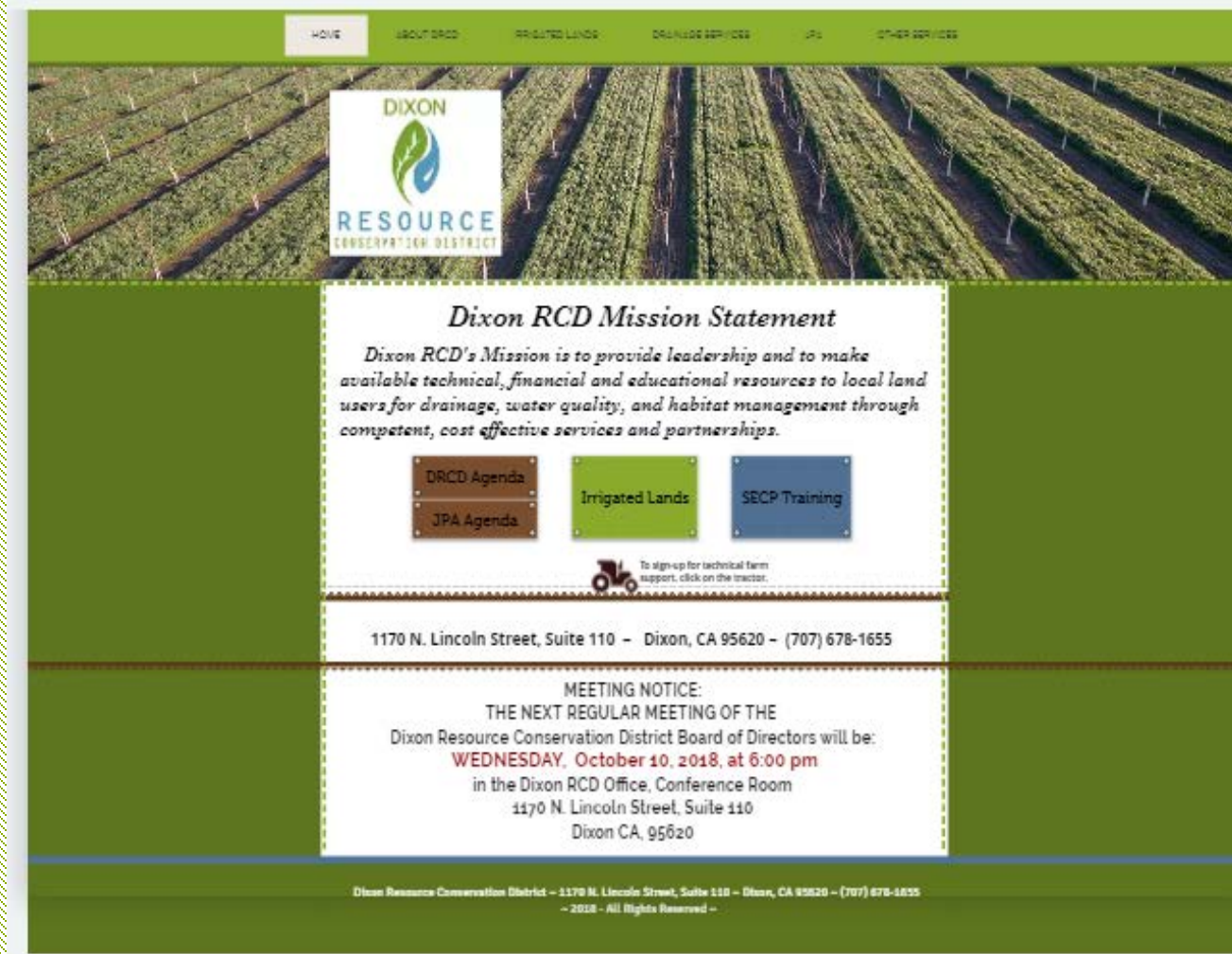
Inspections

- Three site inspections in March 2018
- Regional Board Inspectors reviewed paperwork & practices in field with landowners.
- One site was specifically chosen because they had not turned in paperwork.

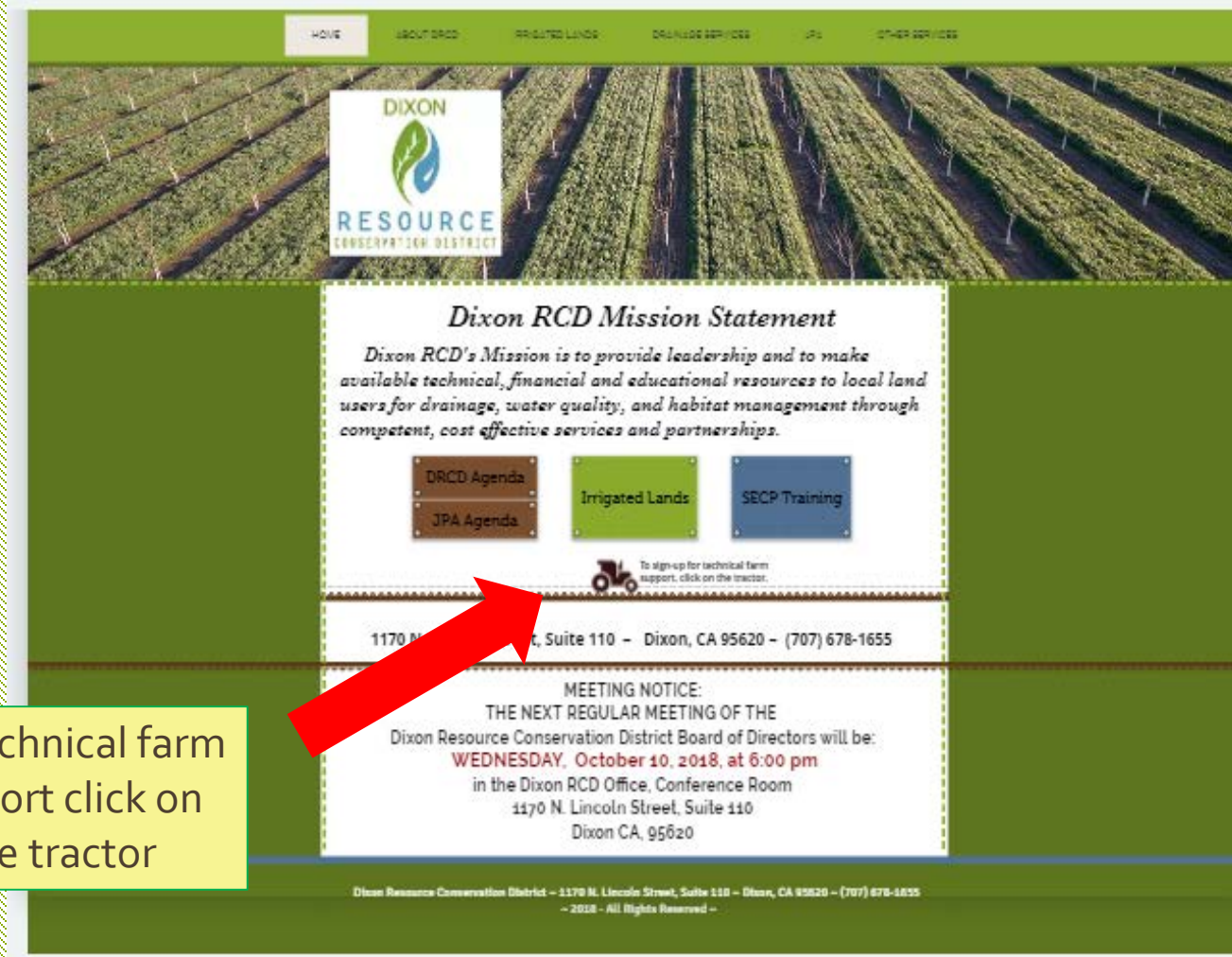
